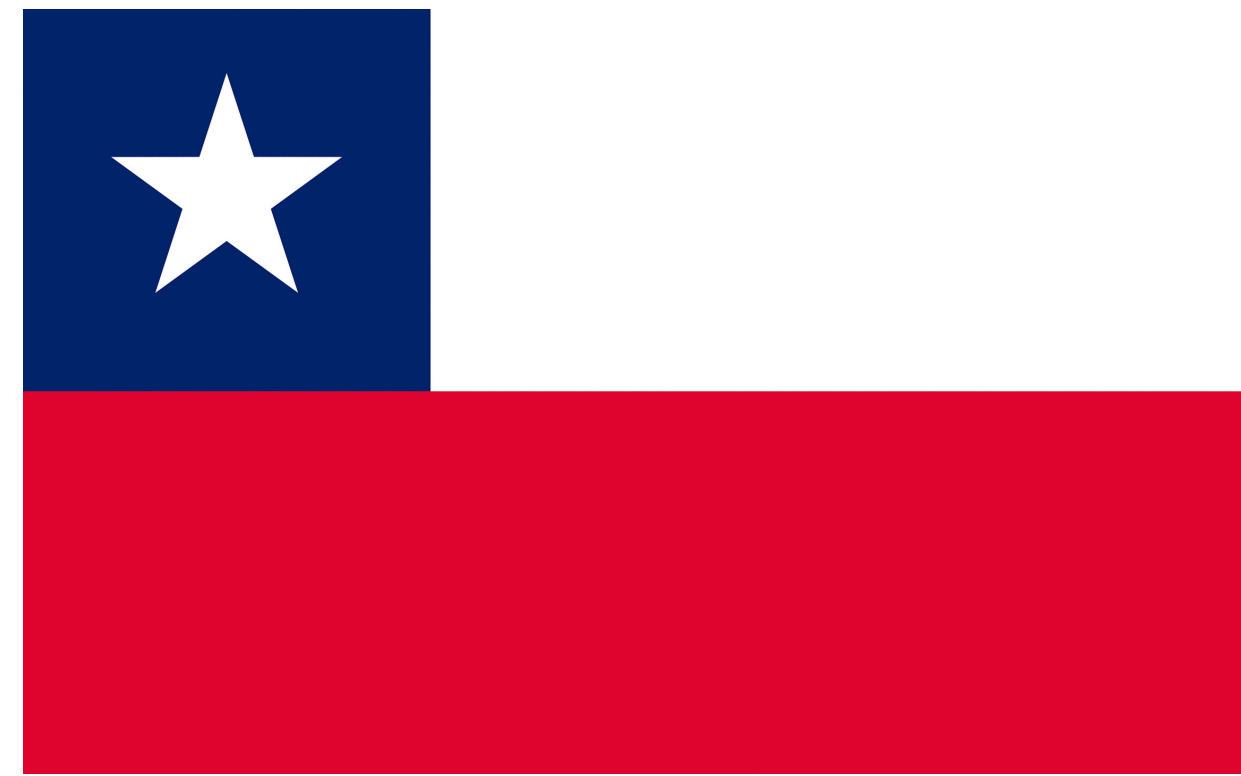




BLUE CROSS CHILE
